

Supervision

Responsible Committee

• Supervision Committee

Outcome of Examination

- Closure Letter
- Remediation Letter
- Potential Breaches
 Letter (automatically escalated to
 Enforcement)

Process Review

- Remedial actions submitted by SP
- Clarifications and supporting documentation (if required)

Closure Letters

 Closure Letter with or without observations

Failure to Remediate

 Case is referred to Enforcement

Enforcement

Trigger

- Potential Breaches Letter
- Failure to Remediate (Supervision)

Responsible Committee

- Compliance Monitoring Committee (CMC)
- 1. Administrative Measures
- 2.Outcome of Directive

Process Review

- Remote meetings held for Remediation and Follow-up Directives
- No. of meetings depend on the severity of the case
- File testing

Closure Letters

- Closure letter with no comments
- Closure with Recommendations
- Closure with Reservations

Failure to Remediate

- Imminent supervisory visit
- Breach of Directive (Penalty/Periodic Penalty Payment)
- Letter of Concerns to Regulators

Repetitive Element

• Administrative penalty to be imposed on new visits will take into consideration repetitive issues
